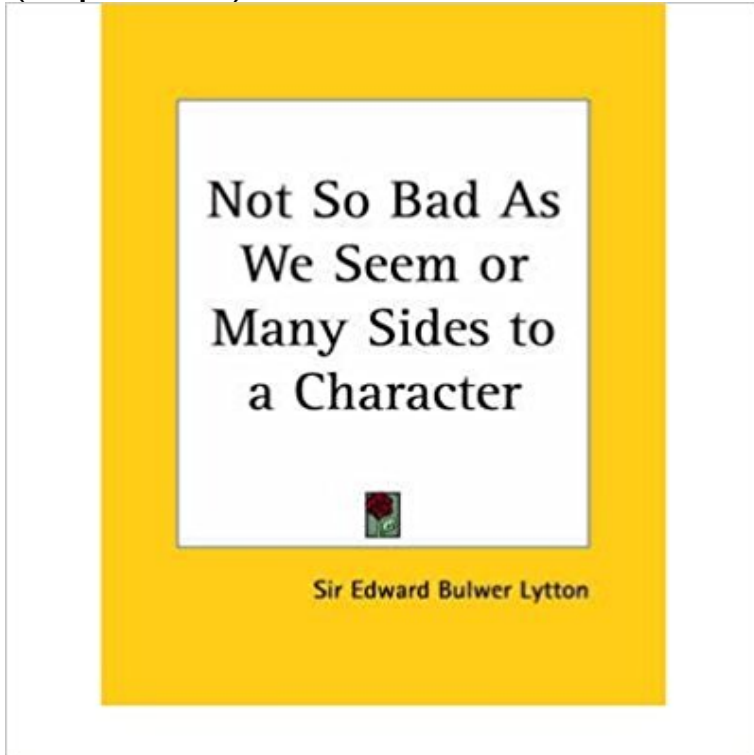


Not So Bad as We Seem or Many Sides to a Character (1851) (Paperback) - Common
